Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• understand and follow instructions• understand key words regarding familiar contexts (food, school vocabulary, hobbies, animals, professions) to answer questions regarding the conversation• understand simple descriptions (colors, sizes)• <u>Need to have this vocabulary to identify it while listening.</u>
